What is Pediatric Neuropsychology?

Pediatric Neuropsychology is a unique specialty that studies how neurological disorders affect the way a child thinks, behaves and learns.

Mt. Washington Pediatric Hospital has a full complement of pediatric neuropsychologists on staff. These specialists have extensive training in cognitive and behavioral disorders, as well as how the brain functions and how certain conditions can affect the way a child thinks, acts, remembers, attends, speaks and feels.

Mt. Washington Pediatric Hospital's Neuropsychological Services include, evaluation and testing, diagnosis, family conferencing, education, treatment, consultations with schools and physicians, and follow-up services.

Neuropsychology Services

We specialize in helping children realize their abilities and overcome obstacles. Our goal is for each child to reach his or her maximum potential. Some of the common diagnoses seen by our staff are:

- Attention deficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD)
- Autism spectrum disorders
- Birth injury/Anoxia
- Brain injury or stroke
- Brain tumors
- Epilepsy
- Genetic anomalies
- Infectious diseases
- Learning disabilities
- Lead poisoning
- Tourette's Syndrome

A Full Range of Care

After a diagnosis is made, our neuropsychologist will work closely with you, the referring physician and your child's teachers to design a personalized treatment plan. A full range of follow-up services is provided at Mt. Washington Pediatric Hospital including: cognitive rehabilitation, outpatient psychotherapy, speech and language, occupational and physical therapy, and medical and psychiatric treatment.

Neuropsychological Evaluation

Your child's evaluation will help answer questions about his or her learning ability and behavior. The evaluation results are used to develop a meaningful treatment plan. During each evaluation, a pediatric neuropsychologist examines a wide range of functions, including:

- Academic skills
- Attention and concentration
- Executive functions
- Intellectual abilities
- Language processing/speech
- Learning and memory capacities
- Motor and sensory capacities
- Social and emotional functioning
- Visual/nonverbal functions
