Rehabilitation Services

Mt. Washington Pediatric Hospital's Outpatient Rehabilitation Services offer physical therapy, occupational therapy and speech therapy for infant-to-adolescent aged children with orthopaedic, neurological, and developmental diagnoses.

Diagnoses seen in Physical and Occupational Therapy include but are not limited to:

- Developmental Delay
- Cerebral Palsy
- NICU Graduates
- Sports Injuries
- Brachial Plexus Injuries
- Brain Injury
- Spinal Cord Injury
- Plagiocephaly Torticollis
- Fine Motor Delays
- Genetic Disorders

Occupational Therapy

Reasons for referrals for Occupational Therapy:

- Handwriting difficulties
- Fine motor skill/Visual perceptual motor deficits
- Sensory Integration/Attention difficulties
- Cognitive group/community re-entry referrals
- Decreased upper extremity strength/Endurance
- Impaired coordination
- Splinting
- Feeding/Eating
- Coordination difficulties
- Brachial Plexus Injuries

Physical Therapy

General areas a Pediatric Physical Therapist treats:

- Gross motor skills
- Balance skills
- Coordination skills
- Strength and endurance
- Range of motion
- Developmental skills
- Functional mobility

Gross motor areas:

- Rolling, sitting, and standing
- Crawling, walking, and running
- Stair climbing
- Jumping, hopping, and skipping
- Throwing, catching, kicking a ball

Speech Therapy

Mt. Washington Pediatric Hospital's Speech Therapy services offer both evaluations and therapies for toddlers, children, and adolescents.

Diagnoses seen in Speech Therapy include but are not limited to:

- Autism Spectrum/Pragmatic Language Disorders
- Articulation
- Apraxia/Dyspraxia
- Phonological Disorders
- Cognitive Communication
- Language, Learning, Literacy Disorders
- Oral-Motor Disorders
- Fluency Disorders/Stuttering
- Auditory Processing Disorders
- Myofunctional Disorders
- Voice Disorders
- Hearing Impaired/Post-Cochlear Implant Rehabilitation
- Augmentative Communication
